- Very proud of the results and the hard work that the teachers and parents are doing
 - Labour Update
 - The Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) confirmed that job action will begin across the province on Monday, September 30. CUPE members include custodial, maintenance, school-based and central clerical, educational assistants, early childhood educators and information technology staff, who provide important services in our schools and workplaces.
 - Thames Valley schools remain open to staff and students during this phase of job action. We are working diligently to minimize any impact on students and the school community; however, we will be unable to completely eliminate all impact. We respect the collective bargaining process and are hopeful for a negotiated agreement. As always, ensuring that our schools are safe environments is our top priority.
 - Noon Hour Supervisors – Hiring additional NHS to help support during CUPE Work to Rule. Safety is our number one priority.
 - School Reorganization took place. Hiring for grade 5 teacher and prep teacher
 - Photo Day – October 17
 - Will check for field trips
 - Kindergarten earlier than last year
 - Volunteer will be available to help from here – Jess is available
